SKELETON CREW stalked the pace from the rail, continued on his left lead in the lane, seized command inside of the pacesetter approaching the eighth pole and widened under a drive. BOOK THE CROOK broke awkwardly, moved up four wide around the turn and rallied for the place. MCCARTY set a pressured pace along the inside, was collared in midstretch, weakened and held clear for the show. BUSTER DOUGLAS lagged inside, swung five wide near the quarter pole and improved his position. TECHNICAL EXPRESS failed to menace while racing three and four wide. ALTA BOY pressed the pace two wide and tired through the lane. DELAWARE DIAMOND was outrun inside. PARKER'SGOLDENCAT chased the pace three wide and retreated in the lane. GIANT PATRIOT stalked the pace three wide, dropped back in the lane and was eased late.
