COTURNIX settled off the pace while racing three wide around the first turn, advanced three wide between foes around the far turn, moved to the front near the eighth pole and held the runner-up safe in the late stages. FRANCESCO PUNCH settled off the pace, moved between foes around the far turn and rallied through the lane. FEISTY ALBERT was unhurried while racing three wide, early, continued three wide between foes around the far turn and rallied for the show. BAKYT saved ground through the opening six furlongs, swung six wide near the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. WHAT A WILDCAT was unruly in the paddock, lacked speed while racing two wide around the first turn, went four wide around the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane and finished with good energy. CLASS CAP was rated back inside and rallied belatedly. PRINCE ROBEAR sprinted clear entering the first turn, held clear past the three-sixteenths pole and tired. TIME TIX AHEAD was outrun while racing three wide. NOBODY BUT YOU never factored while racing four wide. AFTERNOON JAZZ had brief speed two wide. GAMBINE ROAD chased the pace from the rail and faltered around the far turn. BREEZY TOMMIE tracked

the pace two wide between foes and tired in the lane.
