ITS A SCHOOL NIGHT , three wide the first turn, stalked the duel, moved in the two path on the far turn, eased out four wide in upper stretch, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole and lasted. MEMORYS N DREAMS saved ground, swung to the five path approaching the sixteenth pole for clear sailing and closed gamely. GREAT BRITAIN brushed with NARROW BACK leaving the starting gate, saved ground, was in hand waiting for room leaving the far turn, had a nice opening along the rail through the stretch, bid for the lead near the eighth pole then flattened out. NARROW BACK brushed with GREAT BRITAIN leaving the starting gate, saved ground disputing the pace, drifted out turning for home and weakened late. STAY I INSIST dueled two wide, was floated out entering the stretch and weakened in the drive. RUN JAC RUN , swung wide mid way on the far turn, failed to rally. TURN RED , eager to go early, circled the first turn four wide, moved up three wide the far turn and tired in the stretch. WE SHALL BE LUCKY trailed.
