Footnotes

PORONU set a rated early pace while off the rail, moved clear into the turn, drifted out under left handed pressure in mid stretch then held sway under a drive. CRIMSON SUN moved up between rivals early and gained a stalking position, edged closer to loom boldly in mid stretch, shifted in late and continued on gamely. RIGHT OF WAY chased the pace three wide and lacked a solid response. OH MY ME MY was steadied back from between rivals early, angled out mid turn, came four to five wide for the drive and had a belated response. PROVE MEGUILTY saved ground and went evenly. RUN TO THE SUN , between rivals nearing the quarter pole, lacked a rally. IVANTSOFF was not a factor. R. BEE ESS lost ground four wide around the turn and failed to menace. MARTINS POINT broke slowly and was outrun. VICAR IN THE HOUSE failed to keep pace. TALENTED PROSPECT broke alertly to battle inside the winner early, stalked around the turn then gave way along the rail.
