Footnotes

FINGER TAPPING , taken to rate within range, was asked for run leaving the far turn, rallied four wide into the lane, bid to challenge in mid stretch, gained a short lead soon after, duelled and got the bob in an extended drive. UNION CHAPEL prompted the pace two to three wide, moved to challenge in upper stretch, gained a brief lead in mid stretch, dueled inside the winner and just missed in a sharp effort. PAPA IM , unhurried early while saving ground, moved up along the rail leaving the three sixteenths marker, swung out in mid stretch and rallied mildly. FATHER U stalked the pace while saving ground, lacked room along the rail in mid stretch, altered out, worked between foes a sixteenth out and finished willingly. PEACE PIPE broke sharply, set the pace two wide into the lane, dueled nearing mid stretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. CRAFTY SON stalked the pace three wide, advanced some four wide nearing the furlong marker then faded. HISHI SOAR lacked speed, saved ground into the lane and failed to menace. LITTLE B P saved ground early, swung out four to five wide leaving the three sixteenths marker but lacked a rally. PEACEFUL DOVE , three wide nearing the half mile marker, raced wider into the lane and gave way. TAP THE KEYS failed to menace while two wide nearing the quarter pole.
