Footnotes

MAXIMIZE tracked the early pace, moved to command after the seventh hurdle and drew off under a drive. ONE SEA finished up willingly to be clearly second best. MISCHIEF made an early move to stalk the pace, chased into the lane and tired. CUSE , away behind runners, raced wide early and gave way. TRITON LIGHT stalked the pace for nearly two miles and faltered. CLASS CLASSIC dropped back. DEPUTY EMPRESS left the course. DUBAI SUNDAY (JPN) set the early pace, faltered and left the course. EAMONN fell after the ninth and was vanned off. EMBARRASSED , between horses early, left the course before the sixth hurdle. There was a stewards' inquiry but no action was taken.
