GHOST DANCING , patiently rated while saving ground, angled out in upper stretch, responded to left handed pressure near the furlong pole, closed nicely and drew away late. BOPOLENE prompted the pace two wide, dueled on a slim lead past the eighth pole, finished gamely and was clearly second best. BIG PATTI set the pace inside, took pressure into the lane, dueled near mid stretch and weakened. AND A CHERRY TREE stalked the pace between rivals mid turn, came four wide for the drive but lacked a response. HUMORLEE saved ground around the turn, eased out but failed to menace. MEADOW PHONE HOME lost ground four wide stalking the pace, lodged a bid nearing the quarter pole then weakened in the final furlong. SAVVY SOLUTION bobbed when in tight between rivals entering the turn.
