PAUPER'S QUEEN saved ground on the first turn, angled to the two path near the five eighths pole, bid for the lead entering the stretch, drifted in inside the eighth pole and got the nose bob. CONTROLLED NEGLECT, three wide both turns, rallied to just miss. CITRON LADY, outside foes in the stretch, was not a menace and closed the gap late. ASIAN INVASION saved ground, eased off the rail in midstretch and lacked the needed late response. WALLEYEDQUEEN, wide in upper stretch, was not a factor. THE ADJUDANT rushed up in the two path to gain the lead inside the five eighths pole then tired in upper stretch. ELEVEN SIXTYSEVEN was outrun.
