ROXBURY ROCKET sped to the front, set the pace near the rail, opened up in midstretch and held sway under urging. PRINTASTICAT , reluctant to load into the starting gate, gamely rallied in the two path between horses. CAMPBELL CREEK , steadied soon after the break, hugged the rail through the stretch and rallied. NAG NAG NAG , no factor, passed tired rivals. GLIMMERING MOMENT prompted the pace outside the winner, gave way and drifted very wide near the sixteenth pole. SPRING STREET , unruly in the paddock, chased the pace, was well off the rail in the stretch and faltered the final furlong. COYOTE EYES , outrun, was carried very wide by LA CHILITA near the three eighths pole. LA CHILITA bore out badly on the turn, dropped back and was eased.
