PEACE PIPE set the pace, opened up in upper stretch and prevailed under urging. MOON IN saved ground and rallied through narrow quarters in midstretch. FERBER lacked speed, swung to the six path entering the stretch and rallied. GORKY A. , unhurried early, raced between horses and flattened out. CHARLEROI , three wide both turns, chased the pace and weakened. CLASSIFICATION raced inside horses and gave way. KISS OF HONOR was outrun. EDMONTON AFFAIR , wide both turns, weakened.
