Footnotes

MISS LUCY MAE prompted the pace while saving ground, lodged a rail bid to take command in upper stretch, kicked clear under stout right handed pressure, drifted out late and held sway. PURE FANTASY , between rivals leaving the three eighths pole, swung out six wide for room entering the lane and closed nicely. DANIELE MA BELLE , unhurried early, saved ground mid turn, angled out in upper stretch, swung out seven wide leaving the furlong marker and closed willingly. MYSTERIOUSNESS vied between rivals early, chased three wide around the turn, came four wide for the drive, held well to sixteenth pole then was outfinished. WEEKENDONTHEMOON broke in the air, moved four wide under a ride mid turn then went evenly in the lane. MOTHERS EYES saved ground around the turn and failed to respond. STORMIN RACHAEL stalked the early pace while off the rail, was put to a ride mid turn, angled in a furlong out and faded. KANWICAT had speed three wide, moved clear early turn, led to the head of the lane then faltered.
