Footnotes

TURBO COMPRESSOR , clear soon after the break, set a controlled pace in the two path, quickly increased his advantage when set down in upper stretch then was kept under brisk urging to the wire. AIR SUPPORT broke to the left, was checked when bumped and pinched back in a jam up soon after the start, lacked speed, advanced in the four path between horses leaving the far turn and continued gamely through the lane to close on the winner. RAHYSTRADA bore out leaving the starting gate causing a jam up, worked in the two path between horses, dropped back a bit entering the stretch, remained in the two path to the sixteenth pole, swung to the outside at that point and rallied nicely. SMART BID , alertly angled in approaching the first turn, saved ground in a forward position, hugged the rail in the stretch and failed to rally. SILVER TIE AFFAIR , angled to the rail approaching the first turn, saved ground and lacked the needed late response. FORTE DEI MARMI (GB) lacked speed, was outside foes the far turn, swung to the six path in upper stretch then passed tired horses. CASINO HOST , steadied and forced out in the jam up soon after the break, steadied in close quarters approaching the first turn, advanced in the five path on the far turn, and lacked the necessary late effort. HUMBLE AND HUNGRY chased the pace outside the winner, remained prominent to the stretch then retreated through the lane. GOURMET DINNER , unhurried early, raced in the two path much of the trip and weakened. TILDEN LANE , three wide both turns, stalked the pace to stretch then weakened. ATONED was outrun after being forced out soon after the break.
