GAS TANK accelerated to the early lead, saved ground setting the pace, was always clear and prevailed under steady handling. DUTYHONORCOUNTRY , two wide, chased the winner in a game effort. CLASS CAP circled the turn in the three path, failed to be a menace and passed tired foes. SUMMER IN GIZA chased the pace three wide around the turn and gave way in upper stretch. BREEZY TOMMIE hugged the rail and failed to rally. OL' HENRY raced in the two path between horses on the turn and failed to be a factor. SUPER BRIAN was outrun. AFTERNOON JAZZ was outrun.
