Footnotes

LION DOWN BY ME saved ground stalking the duel, hugged the rail in upper stretch, swung to the three path when commencing her bid in midstretch, took command near the sixteenth pole then drew off. MISS OIL , two wide on the turn while stalking the duel, was floated to the four path in midstretch and rallied by tired foes. CARIBBEAN LADY , two wide on the turn, swung to the four path in upper stretch and rallied by tired horses. MOSAICIST (IRE) disputed the pace two wide, gained a clear lead in midstretch and weakened the final sixteenth of a mile. COUNTESS EMMA raced off the rail, passed tired horses and was not a factor. UNO'S WILD ANGEL dueled along the rail and gave way the final furlong. AIX EN PROVENCE , three wide, gave way leaving the turn.
