### Footnotes

FUND BROKER saved ground on the far turn, eased out entering the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and lasted between horses. BOLD TURN , unhurried early, raced along the rail in upper stretch, eased outside in midstretch and rallied. POWER OF PRAYER stalked the pace, raced along the rail in the stretch and hung. RENDON STREET , wide the far turn, failed to sustain his bid. COUNTRY COUSIN , wide the first turn, failed to rally. CHEROKEE SPIRIT set the pace and gave way the final furlong. KING MAXIMUS lacked speed and raced extremely wide in the stretch. MACH THREE was no factor. PURE OXYGEN gave way. SMOOTH TANGO showed speed and faltered. HUMDINGER dropped back. CASANOVA EXPRESS was outrun.
