ALTA BOY was bumped just after the start, pressed the pace two wide, took command in upper stretch, edged clear while drifting out under left-handed urging leaving the eighth then straightened out and held sway under a vigorous hand ride. ETARAG steadied into the turn, saved ground around that bend, tipped into the two path near the quarter pole and finished well. BATON ON FIRE was bumped just after the start, settled off the pace, advanced three wide between horses around the turn and was along late for the show. SILENT TALE was off a step slow, raced three wide into the turn, advanced four wide leaving the five-sixteenths marker and flattened out in the lane. DESERT TIGER was bumped and steadied just after the start, quickly recovered to set the pace along the rail, held well to midstretch and weakened late. DUNCAN MCFLY was bumped just after the start, stalked the pace two wide and came up empty in the drive. STONE DANCER was bumped just after the start, raced two wide and failed to menace. PARKER'S LOVE was no factor inside. MISTER MEEHAN stalked the pace inside and tired in the stretch.
