Footnotes

LONELY WHISTLE set a rated pace along the rail, drew off in upper stretch and held safe under steady urging. PERFECT FOOTPRINT was unhurried along the rail around the first turn, eased outside early on the backstretch, circled four wide around the far turn and rallied through the lane. LUCKIFEE stalked the pace two wide between rivals, swung outside in upper stretch and finished willingly. TIME FOR TUTT broke awkwardly and was in tight soon after the start, lagged inside early, made a strong rail move around the far turn but could not sustain his bid in the stretch. ROYALE raced two wide between foes around both turns and lacked the needed rally. LUCKMAN stalked the pace three and four wide and lacked a closing bid. TIZSILK prompted the pace two and three wide and faded in the stretch.
