Footnotes

SUPER CHUNKY disputed the pace three wide wide down the backstretch, dueled outside of ACTION ANDY around the turn, dropped back a bit turning for home then closed determinedly and drove clear in the final seventy yards. ACTION ANDY dueled between rivals down the backstretch, took a slim lead while continuing to duel inside of the winner around the turn, drew clear in upper stretch, dug in when challenged by the winner inside the eighth pole but could not match strides with that rival in deep stretch. ENNIS stalked the pace two and three wide around the turn, tipped out in upper stretch and finished evenly. EARLY STAR lacked speed inside, swung five wide nearing the quarter pole then rallied belatedly. CONFIRMONDI dueled inside down the backstretch, settled off the duel entering the far turn, stalked the leaders from the rail around that bend then faded in the lane. ANDY'S CHAMP raced three wide around the turn and lacked a closing bid. EL PISTON never threatened while racing inside. REDWOOD FEVER was squeezed back soon after the start then was outrun while racing inside. MANOFTHEWEST raced within striking distance while two wide around the turn, tired.
