Footnotes

SHARED ACCOUNT stalked the pace while racing near the rail around the first turn, settled back a bit while racing between rivals down the backstretch, eased three wide nearing the far turn, moved up while three and four wide around that bend, slowly gained on the pacesetter through midstretch, took the lead near the sixteenth pole and inched away under a steady drive. DYNASLEW raced in mid pack while three wide around the clubhouse turn, came four wide around the far turn, slowly gained in upper stretch, rallied between rivals through the final sixteenth and got up for the place on the wire. TIZAEQUEENA set a rated pace in the two path, inched clear down the backstretch, took some pressure from CASABLANCA SMILE around the far turn, dug in gamely in upper stretch to maintain a short lead past the eighth pole and held well through the final furlong to just miss the place. CASABLANCA SMILE (CHI) prompted the pace while racing just outside of TIZAEQUEENA, moved up to apply pressure outside of that rival around the far turn, battled between rivals through the lane and just missed the place. OMEGA CAT was rated at the rear of the field while racing three wide around the first turn, continued wide down the backstretch, rallied four and five wide around the far turn then finished well down the center of the track. BLIND DATE advanced along the rail around the first turn, stalked the leaders inside down the backstretch and around the far turn then faded in the lane. KITTY CAT EXPRESS was under a firm hold while racing in the two path between rivals through the opening half-mile, continued two wide around the far turn then lacked the needed stretch rally.
