Footnotes

HUMMING ALONG , taken to rate and angled to the rail entering the turn, gathered momentum into the stretch, closed determinedly along the rail under stout left handed pressure and forged ahead in the final yards. BLONDESHAVEMORERUN stalked the pace, rallied three wide into the stretch, moved to command inside the eighth pole, finished gamely but could not withstand the inside challenge from the winner. BO DIDDLEY , brushed at the break, moved up four wide into the turn, continued four wide for the drive, made a mild run in mid stretch then flattened out. HALLUCINOJENIC , outrun early while saving ground, eased out in upper stretch, moved up between rivals near the sixteenth marker then failed to sustain. GOLD IS GOOD sprinted clear early, set the pace two wide into the stretch, was collared leaving the three sixteenths pole, battled past the furlong marker then weakened. HE'S APPEALING , wide, was no factor. CARSON CITY DUDE chased the early pace and dropped back.
