R. B. FLOAT settled back early, worked between runners leaving the five sixteenths marker, shifted out entering the lane, closed determinedly under solid left handed pressure and forged ahead in the final yards. WOLVERTON prompted the pace two wide, moved to near even terms into the far turn, dueled past the three sixteenths marker, briefly shook clear, met challengers from both sides leaving the sixteenth pole and stayed on well. NEW YORK HOLIDAY raced under snug rating while saving ground, slipped through along the rail advancing into the stretch, eased out past the furlong marker, lodged a bid inside of WOLVERTON and hung late. UNBRIDLED MUSIC lagged back early, came five wide for the drive and found his best too late. CRYIN' RYAN cleared early, set the pace towards the rail, was joined after a half mile, dueled to upper stretch and weakened late. REPRISE, three wide in hand in early backstretch, edged closer under a ride past the five sixteenths marker but failed to sustain in the drive. THAT'STHEQUESTION settled back after an alert break, saved ground nearing the quarter pole, altered out and had late interest between runners. VICAR IN THE HOUSE failed to menace. TECHNICAL EXPRESS, towards the inside the stalking the pace, was put to a drive leaving the far turn, gave chase to the quarter pole and weakened. BUSTER DOUGLAS, four wide, gave way. TYRAE, two to three wide pursuing the pace, dropped back before going six furlongs. All fractions and final time were hand timed.
