SECOND FIDDLE lacked speed, swung to the six path entering the stretch, closed determinedly and was along in time. BO DIDDLEY , pinched back leaving the starting gate, saved ground, found room along the rail through the stretch, bid for the lead in midstretch and continued gamely. LUCKMAN , bumped and placed in tight quarters by WILD PAL leaving the starting gate, lacked speed, swung to the five path turning for home and rallied between horses. LEAR HEIGHTS saved ground, swung to the four path leaving the far turn and came up empty in the drive. DELTA MOON set the pace, raced in the two path through the stretch and weakened. WILD PAL bore out leaving the starting gate, prompted the pace outside DELTA MOON and faltered. POR SUPUESTO raced outside horses and gave way. JETS NICE AN NASTY gave way.
