Footnotes

BATTLE OF HASTINGS (GB) , patiently rated, raced wide on both turns, was alertly angled inside leaving the far turn, sprinted to a clear lead under brisk urging in midstretch, dug in tenaciously under vigorous rousing and held sway. STRAIGHT STORY assumed the early lead while kept well off the rail, was put to urging entering the far turn, was carried out to the eight path by AL KHALI entering the stretch, closed gamely and just missed. LIME RICKEY , unhurried early, raced wide around the far turn, angled in near the three sixteenths pole and rallied nicely. TAKE THE POINTS stalked the pace, raced three wide entering the stretch and weakened in the drive. AL KHALI , sent to the lead inside STRAIGHT STORY entering the backstretch, set the pace well off the rail, drifted out badly entering the stretch then gave way in midstretch. RESCUE SQUAD raced near the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. MARK S THE COOLER lacked speed, raced along the rail entering the stretch and failed to rally. FINAL COUNT , between horses on the far turn, gave way. WINNING VOW trailed.
