SAINT ZITA steadied back at the break then settled, angled off the inside for the backstretch run, made steady progress three wide into the far turn, circled four wide into the stretch, rallied under hand urging to collar the leaders exiting the furlong grounds then edged clear at the wire under nice handling. SMOOTHIE LANDING gained a nice spot tracking a three pronged battle through soft fractions, sat patiently along the rail entering the lane, shifted out for a clear run leaving the three sixteenths marker, forged to a brief lead just past the furlong, kept on gamely but simply could not contain the winner's charge. STAR MONEY set a slow pressured pace along the inside, spurted away from GOLLY GIN in upper stretch, was collared nearing the eighth pole, gave brief resistance then succumbed. WADOCASHSKI prompted the pace three wide, came under pressure mid way on the final turn and faded. SUGAH SWEET , unhurried early, saved some ground while making a slight advance into the far turn, swung wide but failed to make an impact. HATTA saved ground and came up empty. GOLLY GIN , keen to go early, vied between rivals past the five eighths pole, pressed the winner three wide into the stretch then weakened.
