**Footnotes**

SILENT TALE saved ground stalking the pace, gained the lead along the rail in upper stretch then drew out under brisk urging. TAKE HEED lacked speed, eased outside in upper stretch and closed nicely. BOATYARD set the pace well off the rail and faltered the final furlong. IRUNALATTE, swung wide in upper stretch, passed tired horses. A STREET, in the three path between horses on the turn, chased the pace and gave way in the drive. JEWELIAM 'N ROSES, four wide on the turn, chased the pace to the stretch then faltered. TOOTH N CLAW, wide leaving the backstretch, was not a factor. HE'S IN THE BAG hugged the rail, weakened and was in close quarters in midstretch. MY KNIGHT SPECIAL, steadied in traffic midway down the backstretch, was outrun. LATER TATER hugged the rail on the turn and dropped back through the stretch.
