CRYPTIC CODE advanced inside down the backstretch, eased out around the final turn, closed determinedly under strong handling and drew clear late. NOTICE THE MAGIC was taken to rate, lodged a bid nearing the quarter pole, went clear in mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. HENDLER lacked speed, checked near the three furlong marker, swung wide and rallied mildly. SUSQUEHANNOCK opened up a long lead, set the pace along the inside to upper stretch then tired. SIN 'N GRIN stalked the pace three wide and weakened. KING SMOKEY, wide, was not a factor. NATTY BOH swung wide for the drive and failed to respond. CALICO SIOUX failed to menace. SHADY VALLEY was outrun. PEPPERBOX stopped and was eased.
