OUTER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination by May 28, 2008. Late nominations close Monday, June 9 at a fee of \$500. \$950 to pass the entry box. \$950 additional to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed, and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The Host Association's added monies to be divided, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup Nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund money not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weights: Three-year-olds 118 lbs., Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of two races of \$50,000 at one mile or over since April 1 2008, allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race since then, 4 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Early nominations closed Wednesday, May 28, 2008; late nominations closed Monday, June 9, 2008, for a total of 56 nominations. Trophy to the winning owner given by the Breeders' Cup Ltd.

Footnotes

LADY DIGBY settled early while off the rail, advanced three wide between rivals nearing the quarter pole, responded to strong left handed urging in upper stretch, forged to command leaving the eighth pole and drew clear under solid right handed encouragement. ECLISSE (FR) opened up early, set the pace towards the inside, drifted out through the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. RUTHERIENNE , unhurried early while removed from the rail, moved closer three wide nearing the lane, advanced between rivals leaving the sixteenth pole and finished willingly. DANCING BAND settled inside, gained ground along the rail in upper stretch, lodged a bid in mid stretch then flattened out. J'RAY , unhurried early while off the inside, gained ground five wide entering the stretch then faded through the final furlong. ROYAL PLEASURE , fractious behind the gate, saved ground into the far turn, angled out near the three eighths pole, moved up some between rivals nearing the stretch then came up empty in the drive. HIGH MOMENT stalked the leader, gained ground leaving the far turn, remained a solid presence to the head of the lane then tired in the drive.
