Footnotes

BOWMAN'S NATIVE stalked the pace from the rail to upper stretch, waited for room in upper stretch, shifted out nearing the eighth pole, shifted further out when TREASURE TRIP drifted out near the sixteenth pole then surged late. TREASURE TRIP prompted the pace three wide, bid three wide around the far turn, took a slim lead in upper stretch, drifted out in midstretch, drifted in leaving the eighth pole then drifted out near the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. BUSTER DOUGLAS set the pace along the rail, dug in when challenged midway around the far turn, dueled inside of TREASURE TRIP past the eighth pole then outfinished in the final furlong. BARNSTORMING was unhurried while racing in the two path early, was under a drive while advancing three wide around the far turn, came four wide at the quarter pole then slowly gained on the leaders through the lane. PROFITABLE prompted the pace while racing between rivals in the two path around both turns then weakened in the lane. SUN AGAIN saved ground and faltered around the far turn.
