MEEZAAN (IRE) circled the turn three wide, bid for the lead outside horses approaching the sixteenth pole then prevailed under brisk urging. CENTURY GOLD saved ground on the turn, bid for the lead along the rail approaching the sixteenth pole then was out finished. DEEP REGRET sped to the front, set the pace in the two path in the stretch and weakened late. OUR HALF, two wide on the turn, chased the pace to midstretch then gave way. CASTLE VICTORY, two wide on the turn, swung to the four path in midstretch and failed to menace. AM SO HAPPY, in the two path between horses entering the turn, came up empty in the stretch. AFTERNOON JAZZ, in close quarters at the break, was outrun and left the turn five wide. TALE OF A MONSTER, four wide turning for home, weakened. MONGOOSE DANCER, steadied leaving the starting gate, trailed.
