KIM'S DIXIE TUNE saved ground to the far turn, eased off the rail on the bend, angled to four path approaching the eighth pole, gained the lead under confident handling near the sixteenth pole and was ridden out. HOUND chased the pace two wide, eased out to the three path entering the stretch, briefly gained a clear lead in midstretch and finished gamely. HANGINGBYATHREAD , two wide in the stretch, bid for the lead in midstretch then was outfinished. OVECHKIN , along the rail in upper stretch, passed tired horses. UNBRIDLED MUSIC was not a factor. BUSTER DOUGLAS , three wide the far turn, floated to the five path in midstretch and weakened. DELAWARE DIAMOND was outrun. LOUANN'S BOOT sped to the early lead, saved ground setting the pace and gave way in the drive. SWING N JONES dropped back, pulled up lame and was vanned off.
