Footnotes

TRAPPE D'OR , inside horses leaving the backstretch, angled to the three path leaving the turn, swung four wide in upper stretch, closed outside POINT MAKER and drove clear. POINT MAKER prompted the pace two wide, took the lead entering the stretch, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, weakened and drifted out near the sixteenth pole. WATCH THE MAGIC hugged the rail on the backstretch, was in tight quarters entering the turn, saved ground, eased out to the two path to go around ALLABOUTFAST in midstretch and rallied inside rivals. MORE GLITTER , four deep leaving the turn, rallied outside horses. WINNING QUEST , along the rail entering the turn, eased out midway on the bend, was prominent to midstretch then weakened. ALLABOUTFAST sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and gave way the final furlong. ROUGH IT UP , fanned wide leaving the turn, gave way.
