Footnotes

CLASS BOPPER three wide the first turn, was nicely rated off the duel, was three deep the far turn, closed late and drove clear. COMPATRIOT had a shoe fixed in the paddock, lacked speed, was four wide the far turn and rallied. DANLY'S DREAM saved ground, disputed the pace, opened a clear lead in midstretch and faded in the drive. TAP'N MY TOES, three wide the first turn, was four deep the far turn and lacked the necessary late response. CATTAIL CREEK, three wide leaving the far turn, was angled to the inner rail in midstretch and failed to be a factor. DELTA RANGER, between horses the far turn, failed to rally, galloped back to the paddock then was vanned off. FLYINGTOBECHILDERS disputed the pace two wide and faltered the final furlong. TETON SUN, two wide the first turn, was all done on the far turn. LIST TICKET raced along the rail and faltered.
