Footnotes

YASINISI (IRE) stalked the pace from the rail around the turn, came inside of the pacesetters in upper stretch, forged to command soon after then inched away under a steady drive through the lane. GHAZIA dueled three wide around the turn, took a slim lead nearing the lane, was carried out by CRAZY LIKE A FOX turning for home then finished willingly to save the place. FIRST COLONY lacked speed inside, advanced inside around the turn, closed along the rail through midstretch then hung late. SOPHISTICATEDEVENT briefly dueled four wide in the early stages, settled off the pace nearing the turn, raced three wide around that bend, swung to the far outside turning for home and rallied mildly. CUT FOR LUCK dueled between rivals around the turn and weakened in the lane. CRAZY LIKE A FOX dueled along the rail around the turn, drifted four wide into the lane and weakened in the drive. NATURES EXPRESS lacked speed in the two path, was hard ridden to make a mild gain leaving the five-sixteenths pole then came up empty in the lane.
