PROTECT THE RING set the pace in the two path, drew clear nearing the far turn, widened around that bend, drew off in upper stretch then held clear under a drive. WOLVERTON lacked speed, raced three wide around the turn, swung six wide nearing the lane and rallied belatedly. GHOSTLY QUIET was forced out near the nine-sixteenths pole, angled to the rail entering the turn, saved ground around that bend, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. PLAY MAN chased the winner while racing just off the rail around the turn, weakened in the drive. SHE'S PRAISE unseated her rider and ran off about three-eighths of a mile before the race, bore out near the nine-sixteenths pole, raced three wide around the turn and lacked a closing bid. ROLL ON ROUGE was off slowly, raced four wide around the turn and was outrun.
