Footnotes

SEXY SANDBAGGER gained a two wide lead approaching the three and a half furlongs pole, opened up turning for home and was under brisk urging in the stretch. MIDSUMMER'S EVE , two wide leaving the turn, angled to the three path in upper stretch and rallied. POLITICAL DIVA circled the turn, was in the four path entering the stretch and rallied mildly. SOMONE SAWEET , in the three path between horses entering the stretch, was checked in tight quarters behind MIDSUMMER'S EVE near the three sixteenths pole, angled in and finished willingly. BOUNDFORTHESHORE , in the four path straightening out for the drive, was not a factor. SWEET TEMPTATION lacked speed, turned for home in the five path and lacked the necessary late response. SPHYNX KEY showed speed along the rail and faltered.
