CHANNEL LADY was lightly bumped at the break, rated kindly while saving ground just off the pace, bobbed entering the far turn but quickly recovered, sat patiently approaching the stretch, surged through between runners leaving the the three sixteenths marker, overtook WELCOME DANCE with a furlong remaining, quickly cleared then held firm under a drive. IDLE TALK settled nicely while saving ground, edged closer leaving the three eighths pole, moved off the inside advancing in upper stretch, altered outside of the drifting APPEALING CAT in mid stretch, was straightened away and finished strong to close the gap. CLARE SKIES AHEAD , unhurried early while inside, was put to a drive leaving the five sixteenths marker, shifted out past the eighth pole and finished with good energy. EMBARR , fractious in the gate, was taken to rate off the rail, gained ground leaving the far turn, angled four wide for the drive, shifted out wider in upper stretch, made a run to the sixteenth marker then flattened out. APPEALING CAT prompted the pace three wide, applied pressure entering the lane, wandered outward in mid stretch despite right handed urging and gave way. ADJACENT relaxed three wide stalking the pace, came under pressure mid way on the final turn but failed to respond. WELCOME DANCE cleared early, set a rated pace towards the inside, repelled a challenge from APPEALING CAT near the quarter, briefly edged clear of that one three sixteenths out, was overtaken by the winner in mid stretch then faltered.
