Footnotes

UNSEEN GLORY lacked speed while racing three wide around the first turn, moved up in the two path around the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch, made a steady gain through midstretch then surged in the final sixteenth and got up in the final strides. KINDA KATTY stalked the pace inside around the first turn, eased two wide down the backstretch, bid two wide around the far turn, took the lead near the eighth pole, inched clear past the sixteenth while still racing on her left lead, drifted out late and was caught in the final strides. PAY YOUR WAY set the pace along the rail, dug in when challenged by KINDA KATTY near the five-sixteenths pole, battled inside of that rival past the eighth pole then weakened in the final furlong. WILL UNBRIDLED broke out, raced three wide around the first turn and never factored. COPPER BEAUTY stalked the pace in the two path through the opening half-mile, angled to rail nearing the far turn then dropped inside around that bend. CRUISIN' BROKE was pulling early, raced three wide throughout and faded in the lane. ARGON was outrun inside.
