QUECHEE raced in mid pack while hung three wide throughout, bid between rivals around the far turn, took a short lead in upper stretch, lost the advantage in midstretch then finished gamely between rivals to prevail. LONESOME NUN lacked speed three wide through the opening mile, advanced four wide around the far turn, loomed boldly in upper stretch and hung. MASK AND WIG settled off the pacesetter while two wide through the opening three-eighths, ranged up to take command nearing the wire the first time, set the pace along the rail thereafter, lost the lead in upper stretch, fought back to regain a slim advantage while dueling inside in midstretch but was out gamed in the final strides. GLOBAL GENIUS (IRE) was bumped just after the start, saved ground early, advanced three wide around the far turn, shifted to the far outside in midstretch and rallied through the final furlong. WANTAN (ARG) was bumped just after the start, raced in mid pack between rivals and lacked the needed stretch rally. T. BONE PICKENS was forwardly placed along the rail then faded after a mile. SERMON OF LOVE saved ground to no avail. CLASS INDIAN sprinted clear soon after the start, rated back the first time through the stretch, remained forwardly placed through the opening mile then tired around the far turn.
