**Footnotes**

BRIGHT GREEN prompted the pace three wide, reached near even terms in upper stretch, dueled outside of GROOVIN POINT through the lane and inched ahead through the final seventy yards under steady left-handed urging. GROOVIN POINT set the pace along the rail, dug in when initially challenged by the winner in upper stretch, dueled inside that foe past the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. REINE DE BONBON was unhurried along the rail early, made a steady gain along the inside in the stretch, angled three wide leaving the sixteenth pole and rallied to just miss the place. RUNNINGLIKEANANGEL lacked speed while racing two wide between foes, swung four wide in upper stretch and rallied outside. MORE THAN MAGIC was off a step, advanced two wide between rivals but flattened out in the final furlong. KILMERS POINT flashed speed between rivals down the backstretch and faded. MIGHTY TITE raced three wide around the turn, came five wide into the lane and never threatened. SEEING DOUBLE saved ground and tired. CLASS BAND stalked the pace four wide and faltered.
