MISS TROUBLE , taken to rate along the inside, moved closer into the far turn, angled out three to four wide nearing the quarter pole, rallied to command leaving the furlong marker and edged clear under a drive. FLASHY THREE (GB) was rated back off of the lead near the three quarter pole, angled out and stalked the pace three wide, lodged a bid nearing the quarter pole, took a short lead in upper stretch, was collared in mid stretch and saved the place. BRIGHTSIDE , unhurried early while off the rail, came four to five wide for the drive and rallied mildly. RUNAWAY MARTHA , unhurried early while saving ground, angled out to advance between rivals near mid stretch then flattened out. TRUE TO FORM saved ground, made a nice run into the lane then had no further response. NAGEM NAGEM NAGEM was outrun. KSCHESSINKA dueled early two wide, moved clear into the backstretch, set the pace to the quarter pole then weakened. ME IN SHADES broke down nearing the far turn.
