STAKES All Along Breeders' Cup S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

OUTER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination. \$950 to pass the entry box. \$950 additional to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed, and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The Host Association's added monies to be divided, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup Nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund money not awarded will revert back to the fund. Supplemental nominations of \$1500 each will be accepted by the usual time of entry with all other fees due as noted. Weights: Three-year-olds 118 lbs., Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of two races of \$50,000 at one mile or over since April 1 2006, allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race since then, 4 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Field will be limited to fourteen starters. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations Closed May 15, 2006, with 69 nominations. Trophy to the winning owner given by the Breeders' Cup Ltd.

FILM MAKER settled nicely along the inside, angled out nearing the quarter pole, responded to left handed urging in upper stretch, surged to command near the sixteenth marker then eagerly drew away under intermittent right handed encouragement. LATICE (IRE) , unhurried early while removed from the rail, was urged along three wide leaving the three furlong marker, angled out four to five wide for the drive and closed willingly to be clear for the place. ART FAN cleared into the first turn, set the pace along the inside, widened under some urging leaving the far turn, remained well clear in upper stretch, was collared leaving the eighth pole and weakened late. HUMORISTIC , well in hand early, prompted the pace two wide down the backstretch, was asked for run mid way around the final turn but came up empty in the drive. WEND , three wide stalking the pace, was put to strong urging leaving the far turn, failed to respond and gave way. JOINT ASPIRATION (GB) , allowed to settle while saving ground, was roused left handed entering the lane, angled out then had no response.
