KING'S CORONATION cleared early and set the pace in the two path, was navigated towards the rail leaving the four and a half furlong marker, responded to open up in upper stretch then held firm. FIRST AND BAY was steadied off heels into the first turn, moved up along the rail mid way down the backstretch, altered out after the winner was guided inward, chased and finished up willingly. EVENING CONCERTO, unhurried early while off the rail, circled four wide into the stretch and finished with some interest. PLEZE MR PRESIDENT saved ground early, swung out five wide for the drive but failed to generate the needed rally. KID CAROUSEL, four wide the first turn, raced three wide leaving the far turn, chased and weakened. RUTLEDGE STAR broke down leaving the eighth pole. An objection by the rider of FIRST AND BAY against the winner for alleged interference in the run down the backstretch was not allowed
