Footnotes

BUSTER DOUGLAS , wide to clear around the first turn, set a rated pace in the two path, drifted out under left handed pressure leaving the eighth pole, was straightened away and dug in under strong handling to prevail. BLONDESHAVEMORERUN , four wide in range, closed willingly and steadily gained. IMPERIAL GIN , rated between rivals early, came four wide for the drive and found his best stride too late. HOT WINK , between horses early, angled in leaving the three eighths pole, made a steady rail run into the lane and flattened out. LEAR HEIGHTS lacked speed, came five wide for the drive and had a

belated run. KJO , three to four wide, failed to respond. COMEBACK PAPA failed to menace. CLASS MARK was not a factor. IT'S A G MAN stalked the pace and tired in upper stretch. HEY JOHNNY JOHNNY saved ground and tired leaving the far turn. DIXIE THIEF was outrun. CAESAR'S GOLD broke slowly and was outrun. PAID PREVIEW saved ground and tired. FOREST BELL lost ground four to five wide, made a mild run near the far turn, failed to sustain and tired.
