Footnotes

LIVE THE DASH settled off the pace while racing along the rail, waited for room from the five-sixteenths marker to midstretch, tipped out near the eighth pole and closed with a rush. ROCKABY BAY prompted the pace from the rail, took the lead midway around the far turn, drew clear in upper stretch, continued in his left lead, drifted out late and led until the final strides. POWDER MOUNTAIN raced between foes near the rear of the field, checked off heels leaving the three-quarter pole, advanced between foes around the far turn, swung further out near the quarter pole and rallied. ROCK IN BAGE (BRZ)

raced three and four wide and rallied outside. FIRST AND BAY set the pace off the rail, drifted out nearing the five-sixteenths marker, faded, drifted in and bumped with FLY BY PHIL in deep stretch. FLY BY PHIL stalked the pace inside, lacked the needed rally and was bumped late. AMERICAN RANSOM advanced between foes around the turn but failed to threatened in the drive. CHEDI stalked the pace outside and lacked a closing bid. SACRED SOUL steadied early, raced five wide and never factored. STORMY THE CAT never factored. EXCESSIVE ASSAULT was outrun inside. EL PISTON saved ground to no avail.
