Footnotes

PIR AT THE MOON saved ground stalking the pace, swung three wide in upper stretch, closed and drove clear. VICTORY SIGN lacked speed, raced three wide between horses in the stretch and rallied. FREE DUBAI , two wide between horses on the far turn, swung four wide entering the lane and rallied. MAJOR PARKER prompted the pace three wide and weakened. RAJASTHAN saved ground setting a pressured pace and gave way late. BOLD TURN failed to sustain his bid. TURK'S RANSOM raced along the rail in the stretch, swung out near the sixteenth pole and failed to rally. SON OF SLAM , four wide the first turn, was five wide leaving the far turn and failed to be a factor. SOUTHERN ADMIRAL prompted the pace two wide and faltered. OAKRIDGE STAR , wide the far turn, faltered.
