### Footnotes

I'M UNFORGETTABLE raced in the two path around the first turn, angled toward the rail nearing the far turn, advanced inside around that bend, swung three wide at the quarter pole, quickly moved to contention, inched away on her left lead near the sixteenth pole and just lasted under a strong drive. MARMORA was unhurried inside early, advanced along the rail around the far turn, waited for room in upper stretch, split horses leaving the sixteenth pole and finished strongly to just miss. COUNT TO ELEVEN was unhurried in the two path early, tipped three wide nearing the quarter pole, angled wider leaving the three-sixteenths pole and was along for the show. FLOMAR pressed the pace in the two path, dueled between rivals through midstretch and weakened a bit in the late stages. UPTOWN set the pace along the rail, dug in when challenged approaching the lane, dueled inside past the eighth pole and weakened in the final sixteenth. SISTER BERTA failed to menace while racing three and four wide. READY SET GO lacked speed three wide, passed tiring rivals in the lane. DIVINE KRYSTAL raced five wide around the first turn, faded three and four wide around the far turn. SILK PERFECTION was reluctant to load, off slowly, raced four wide and was outrun. ENTRY CODE stalked the pace in the two path and tired. L'ARGENT HALO flashed brief speed inside.
