Footnotes

HOLD ON SMOKEY prompted the pace outside INDEFINABLE HUMOR, overtook that one in upper stretch then dug in tenaciously to hold on. LOVE THOSE BOOTS stalked the pace, left the turn three deep, had aim on the lead in midstretch, swung to his left lead near the sixteenth pole and hung. AGONISTIC saved ground on the turn, eased out to the two path in upper stretch and finished gamely. HESAGOLDMINE lacked speed, swung wide leaving the turn and rallied. WIRE FUNDS, swung wide approaching the stretch, lacked a rally. GRAIN, always well off the rail, was no factor. WAR COLONY was outrun. INDEFINABLE HUMOR set the pace along the rail, remained prominent to midstretch then faltered.
