MISS TONI, taken to rate while off the rail, swung out six to seven wide in upper stretch, surged past the dueling leaders near the sixteenth pole and drew clear under a drive. MELOLINK duelled two to three wide, held a short lead into the lane, drifted out in the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. KOUSA stalked the pace four to five wide, moved closer into the lane, lodged a bid to be on near even terms in mid stretch, was floated out late and hung. PASSION N ROMANCE stalked the dueling leaders mid turn, lodged a bid inside foes in mid stretch then faded. STARRY VALLEY, well wide throughout, lacked a solid response. ROLLIKING RUBY was steadied briefly nearing the turn, made a mild run between foes leaving the eighth pole then flattened out. SIOUX'S TESTAMONY passed tiring rivals. LOVE FOR JENNY was steadied at the break. SUCH A REALITY saved ground into the turn and failed to respond. CONFEDERATE GAL duelled along the rail to the head of the lane then tired. DORMELLO STAR was outrun. LEMON BLITZ stalked the pace three wide and tired in upper stretch.
