Footnotes

NIKOLDINI , three wide entering the first turn, stalked the pace, advanced in the three path on the far turn, took command in upper stretch, proved best under brisk urging and drifted out near the sixteenth pole. SKIP THE RATE lacked speed, moved up in the four path approaching the stretch and rallied outside the winner. SCREAMING MIMI hugged the rail on the far turn, eased out to the two path in upper stretch, had room inside the winner in the drive but flattened out. MONATELLA set a pressured pace, was two wide on the far turn, remained prominent to midstretch then weakened. STAY AT HOME MOM , kept in the four path down the backstretch, stalked the pace and faltered near the three eighths pole. GINGERBRED GIRL , a forward factor along the rail, stopped after a half mile. GREATNESS RULES , steadied on the heels of a rival soon after the break, was outrun.
