**Footnotes**

AZAZEL lacked speed, raced between horses in upper stretch, closed and was along in time. SHADY VALLEY raced very wide into the stretch and rallied. DISTINCT POWER raced very wide and rallied. HATTON CROSS saved ground, swung to the four path at the head of the stretch and flattened out between rivals. AQUIESS had a slight rally between horses. PALS PRIDE raced along the rail through the stretch and came up empty. MR. ACE weakened. TRES TOUCHE dropped back. HAWAIIAN SNICKERS , wide, fell back. JAVA JAKE pressed the pace while wide and stopped back. AWADS AWARD stopped and was eased. ARTILLERY MAN drifted out on the first turn, set the pace well off the rail and lost his rider when bearing out sharply leaving the far turn.
